USE SECURE PASSWORDS

It only takes 2 seconds to crack an eleven-character password that uses only numbers.

Use strong and unique passwords or passphrases for every account and device.



CLICK WITH CAUTION

A cuber attack occurs every 39 seconds!

Never click links or open attachments from unknown senders. To be safe, report suspicious emails to the Help Desk.



APPLY UPDATES

Applying updates is the most important step you can take to keep your devices safe.

Enroll in auto updates or apply updates as soon as available.



KNOW YOUR RISK

Yale classifies data based on risk - high, moderate, and low - and has approved services for each risk level.

☐ Know your data and ensure you are protecting it properly. Report any lost or stolen devices to the Information Security Office.
